Ritva Mitchell has extensive professional experience as a cultural policy researcher, policy analyst, teacher and consultant, with a particular emphasis on European and international dimension of cultural policies. She was responsible for eight cultural policy review processes while working at the Council of Europe, as well as managing the production of the Council of Europe's report In from the Margins (1997).

Recently she has deepened her expertise in Asian and Arab cultural policies. Prior to her work at the Council of Europe she was responsible, at the Arts Council of Finland, for a multitude of studies concerning the status of artists, and has recently also been involved in guestions concerning gender. mobility of artists and cultural workers, intercultural dialogue, culture and development and creative industries. She is responsible for the research sub-project in a three-year ESF funded development project Creative Industries Finland (2008-2010) coordinated by the Aalto University.

As Director of Research of the Foundation for Cultural Policy Research (Helsinki) she is also actively engaged in studying urban cultural policies(in collaboration with Finnish cities), multiculturalism and cultural diversity, impact of aging on cultural activities, cultural statistics (in collaboration with Statistics Finland), cultural indicators (for the Finnish Ministry of Education and Culture) and cultural impact studies. The most recent work carried out in the institute concerns economic, social and cultural impact of copyright, a new framework for impact assessment will be presented to WIPO at the beginning of next year.

Ritva Mitchell has written and lectured intensively on comparative cultural policies, on managing cultural organisations and on global governance of culture and led numerous expert teams reporting on different aspects of national and international cultural policies and cultural development.
